### **South wall of the Nave**

This tablet was erected and the church road was made in memory of Mary Elizabeth Marshall born 11.12.1878 died 1.4.1944 also of Richard Marshall born 21.11.1879 died 9.3.1956 Churchwarden of St Martin's 1923-1956.

### **Table in the Nave**

Presented to St Martin's Church in memory of John Stickney Hoe, Churchwarden 1927-1951.

### **On the chancel floor**

Hic jacet dns Thomas Asterby dudum Rector de Welton juxta Ludam qui obid    die mensis  
anno anno dni MCCCCXX cuius animi propicietur deus amen.

### **Under an arch in the wall on the north aisle of the church**

Hic jacet Isabella uxor Johnis Gee quae obit in festo    ano dni 1386 jujus anime propcietur  
deus.

### **On a shield on the north east wall of the nave aisle behind the organ screen**

Hic jacet Johannis Dyon

Here lyeth the body of John Dyon Esq who departed this life ye 24<sup>th</sup> day of May 1575.

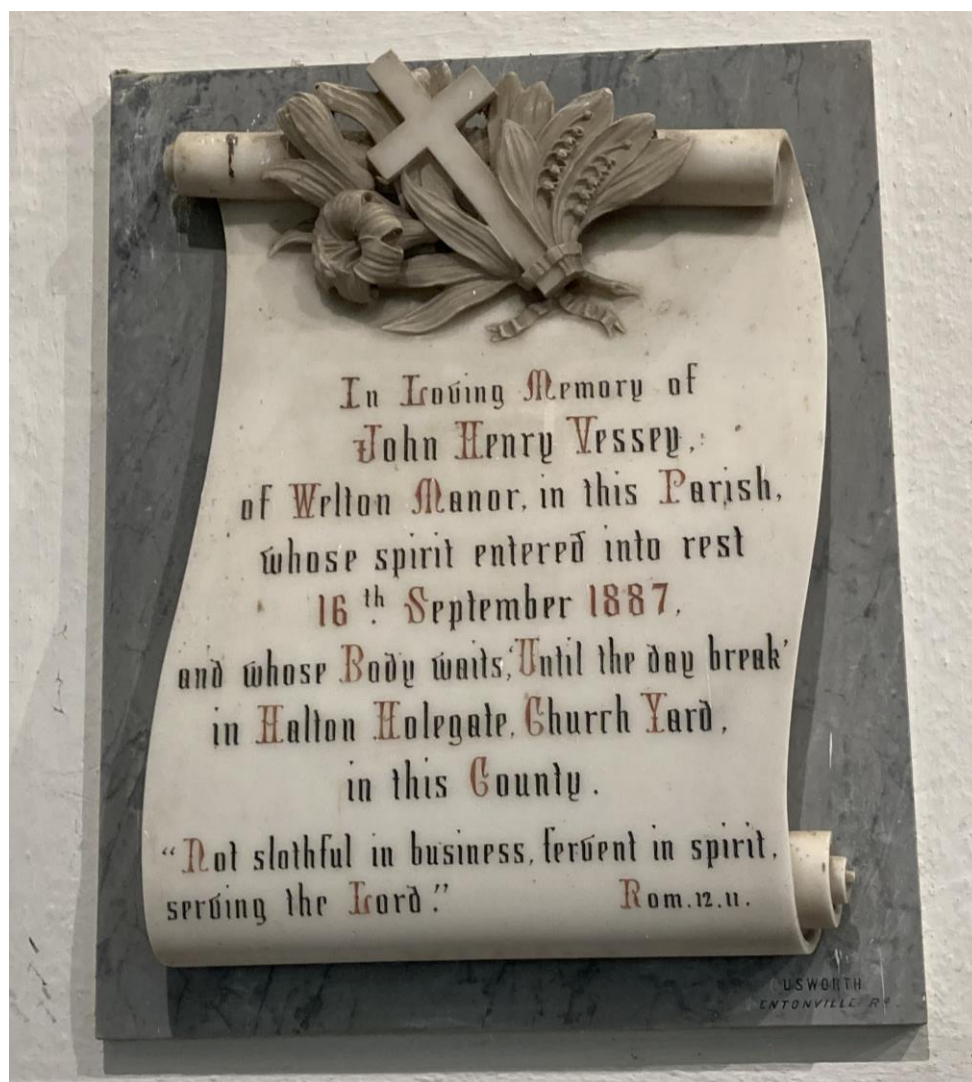
THIS TABLET WAS ERECTED AND THE CHURCH ROAD WAS MADE AND FENCED IN MEMORY OF MARY ELIZABETH MARSHALL, BORN 11<sup>TH</sup> DEC 1878. DIED 1<sup>ST</sup> APRIL 1944. ALSO OF RICHARD MARSHALL BORN 21<sup>ST</sup> NOV 1879, DIED 9<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 1956 CHURCHWARDEN OF ST MARTIN 1923-1956.

THIS TABLET WAS ERECTED IN LOVING MEMORY OF RICHARD SOLOMON MARSHALL DEAR SON OF MARY ELIZABETH & RICHARD MARSHALL BORN 8<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 1911 DIED 1<sup>ST</sup> DECEMBER 1985. CHURCHWARDEN OF ST MARTIN'S 1954-1982. ALSO HIS BELOVED WIFE HELEN MARIAN MARSHALL BORN 26<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 1912 DIED 29<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 1997 (pictured below):

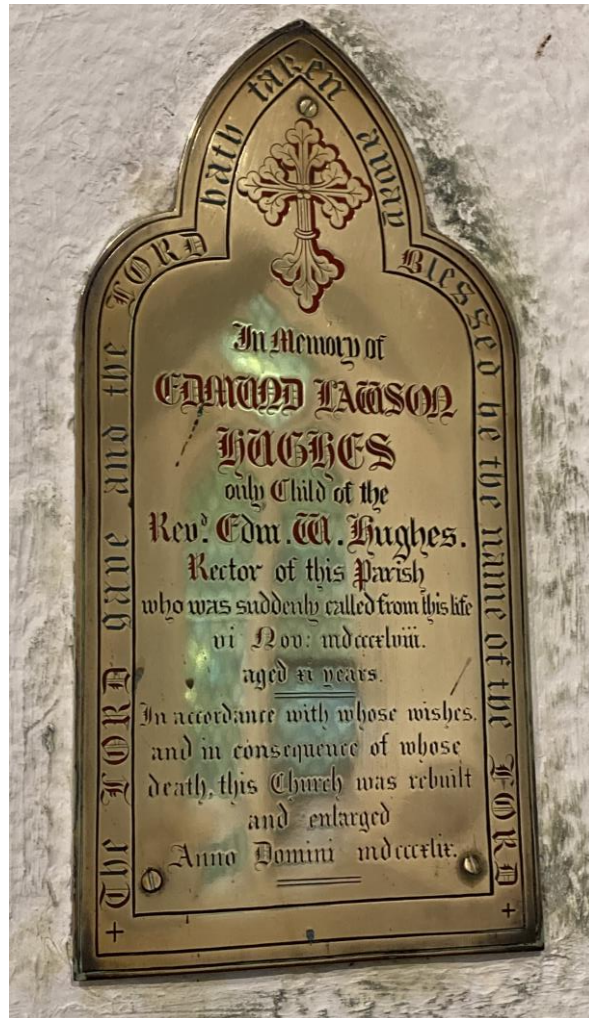
### Chancel, south wall

IN TENDER AND REVERENT MEMORY OF MARY ISABEL FOR THIRTY YEARS THE DEVOTED WIFE OF THE REV. WM. H. HINDLE M.A. RECTOR OF THIS PARISH. ELDEST DAUGHTER OF THE LATE RICHARD HOBBS TAUNTON OF BROOK VALE WITTON, WARWICKSHIRE. DIED AT WELTON MAY 24<sup>TH</sup> 1921. AGED 55 YEARS. ALSO IN PROUD REMEMBRANCE OF THEIR ELDEST SON MICHAEL WILLIAM MAXWELL OF EXETER COLLEGE OXFORD. LIEUT. 8<sup>TH</sup> BATT. DEVONSHIRE REGT. WHO FELL IN THE GERMAN TRENCHES AT LOOS ON SEPT 25<sup>TH</sup> 1915 IN HIS 23<sup>RD</sup> YEAR.
